Child Development

Child Development program known as "Asha Kiran.... a ray of hope" seeks to bring out of school children back to formal school

- Ashø Kiran- implemented by shortlisted NGOs
- Out-of-school children are identified and go through special training classes - Asha Kiran Centres

After adequate relearning, these children are mainstreamed in age-appropriate classes in government/aided schools.





Who are the Asha Kiran Children/Beneficiaries?

Children between age group 7 to 14 years, who:

- hay e never been to school
- are not attending school but nominally enrolled, irregular, laggard or absent for more than 45 days without informing the school

Priørities to be given to following socially vulnerable groups:


Children from socially and economically disadvantaged and vulnerable communities like children of migrant workers, victims of child labour practices, tribal communities and children in need of care and atotection etc.

- To mainstream 1.5 lacs out of school children back to school

 - Building partnership with \$tate Government








Way Forward: Vision 2020 -2025

Asha Kiran Implementation Process



- Proposals invited from NGOs
- Finalisation through desk and field assessments
- Identification of out-of-school children by NGOs
- Screening and approval of children by RILM and Rotary Clubs





Asha Kiran Implementation Process

- Enrolment for special training classes at Asha Kiran Centre for 6-9 months
- Community mobilization by discussion with the parents and other stakeholders to send the children to Asha Kiran center/school
- Mainstreaming in govt. schools when children attain appropriate earning levels and complete minimum 3 months training in Asha Viran Centre.


