- Integrated product of hardware and software where the hardware is an LCD projector or Television set
- Single classroom installation in Government/aided schools. Schools should have the following -
 - ✓ Availability of electricity/ solar power.
 - ✓ Dedicated classroom with white wall / flex fit mounted on the wall.




E-learning installation across India benefitting 25 Lakh (approx.) Students and 45,000 teachers

Steps to implement E-learning

- Coordination with Education Department
- Survey of the school
- Finalizing vendor with support from RILM
- Installations of E-learning kit and branding
- Teacher training on hardware at the time of installation
- Centralized teacher training on software in a batch
- Display of plaque in the school for branding





Impact Assessment by RILM

- Impact assessment done by RILM
- Timeline of collection of data for assessment:
 - ✓ Before /At the time of installation (SECTION A)
 - ✓ In between 1st year (mid of the year) (SECTION B)
 - ✓ End of 1st year (SECTION C)
