







INDIA LITERACY SCENARIO



Literacy rate in 731 Districts of India








T-E-A-C-H MODEL

<u>Happy School</u>: Upgrading elementary schools to Happy Schools to curtail student dropouts

<u>Child Development</u>: Sending out-ofschool children back to school after the children reach their age appropriate learning level at an intermediary center






